On 07/23/2017, While on patrol at Hwy 142 and Industrial Blvd I observed a blue ford Explorer fail to maintain lane several times while I was behind it. I could see that the male driver was looking down while driving and did not pick his head up. I then turned on my blue lights and siren to make a traffic stop. I then made contact with Mr. Hawkins. I could see that Mr. Hawkins was sweating, pupils were dilated, pulse rate was beating fast from his carotid artery, and would not stop talking when other officers arrived on scene.

I obtained Mr. Hawkins license to run his information through NCIC/GCIC to check for wants and warrants. Mr. Hawkins license came back as suspended for failure to appear. Mr. Hawkins was asked to step out of the vehicle. Once out of the vehicle, I placed Mr. Hawkins in handcuffs that were doubled locked and checked for tightness. Mr. Hawkins was then searched and taken to my patrol vehicle and placed into the back seat. I was then informed that there was a clear plastic bag with a shard of Methamphetamine inside, that Ofc. Hunter #258 observed in plain view in the vehicle and took possession of.

After Mr. Hawkins was arrested, Officer Hunter and I searched the vehicle for additional narcotics or contraband. While searching the vehicle, I located in the back passenger seat on the right side, a blue pair of swim shorts with a glass pipe wrapped in a american flag handkerchief. The glass pipe had a white residue inside if it that I believed to be Methamphetamine. I found on Mr. Hawkins vehicle key ring, a small black case with Pugs written in red. Inside of the Pugs case was a pipe with white residue inside of it believed to be Methamphetamine, there was also a razor blade and 2 clear wrappers with white residue inside of them believed to be Methamphetamine. Ofc. Hunter found a black tin case in the center console and a glass mirror with a razor scratch marks on the passenger side seat tucked down in the gap between the console and the seat. Both of these items also had a white powder residue believed to me Methamphetamine.

All items found were bagged and put into the trunk of my patrol vehicle.

Mr. Hawkins wife was contacted and arrived on scene shortly after. Mr. Hawkins turned over his vehicle to his wife. Mr. Hawkins was transported to the newton county jail, were he was charged with Failure to maintain lane, Distracted driving, Suspended license, Poss of a schedule II drug and drug related objects. Warrants will follow.

All items obtained from the traffic stop were put into evidence under property receipt number B 28457.
