Teen melee that led to gunfire investigated

COVINGTON, Ga. — A large group of teens reportedly mostly escaped injury Saturday night after a Halloween party at a west Newton event venue ended with numerous fights and gunshots ringing out. The Newton County Sheriff's Office (NCSO) was investigating Tuesday following the 11:30 p.m. incident

Saturday in the parking lot of Salem Square shopping center on Salem Road near Old Salem Road, said NCSO spokesperson Caitlin Jett.

No one was injured by the gunfire, though the NCSO received a report of a girl at the scene being hit by a car while she rushed to leave the scene, Jett said.

There were no reports of the girl being injured.

Deputies detained four juvenile boys — a 15-year-old, two 16-year-olds and an 18-year-old, Jett said.

Charges included one count each of possession of a handgun by someone under age 18, and theft by receiving stolen property, a NCSO incident report stated.

"Two of the juveniles did have a firearm on their person, and one of the firearms was stolen out of Cobb Coun-

ty," Jett said.

Deputies seized as evidence a Glock 19X semi-automatic handgun; a Glock 19 semi-automatic handgun reported stolen from Cobb County; a handgun magazine with 13 bullets and an extended magazine with nine bullets, a report stated.

Jett said the party — which attracted

Election 2022: Race for Governor

Abrams to campaign in Covington

COVINGTON, Ga. — Democrat Stacey Abrams is set to campaign in Covington Thursday, Nov. 3, at 5 p.m. at the CWA Union Hall on City Pond Road.

The union hall is at 9915 City Pond Road.

The stop in Covington is part of her "Let's Get It Done" statewide bus tour before Election Day Tuesday, Nov. 8, her campaign announced.

The bus tour also is making stops in Macon and Clayton, Gwinnett and Cobb counties this week.

"Throughout the bus tour, Abrams has traveled the state to speak with Georgians of all backgrounds about her vision for One Georgia and the once-in-a-generation opportunity that Georgia has to invest in the fundamentals: education, healthcare, housing, and the ability to earn a good living, whether you work for yourself or someone else," a release stated.

Abrams is challenging Gov. Brian Kemp for the governor's office in the General Election Tuesday, Nov. 8. Libertarian Shane Hazel also is on the ballot for governor.

Her theme on the campaign trail has been about the opportunities Kemp is missing to use a surplus generated by massive federal pandemic relief — not Kemp — to improve education, housing and health care for everyday Georgians, Capitol Beat News Service reported.

She has also criticized Kemp and two Republican predecessors in the Governor's Mansion for

Sheriff's Office awarded \$325,889 grant for local DUI enforcement

COVINGTON, Ga. — The Governor's Office of Highway Safety has announced that the Newton County Sheriff's Office is one of 21 law enforcement agencies in Georgia to receive a Highway Enforcement of Aggressive Traffic (HEAT) grant for the 2023 Fiscal Year.

Referred to as a H.E.A.T. grant, Newton County Sheriff's Office's

award totals \$325,889.

The goal of the H.E.A.T. program is to combat crashes, injuries and fatalities caused by impaired

driving and speeding, while also increasing seatbelt use and educating the public about traffic safety and the dangers of DUI.

The Newton County Sheriff's Office H.E.A.T Unit will use the grant from GOHS to develop and implement strategies to reduce local traffic crashes due to aggressive and dangerous driving behaviors.

Sheriff Ezell Brown said, "This grant will assist the agency in its efforts to make the highways in

Newton County safer, especially as the holiday season rapidly approaches."

Allen Poole, director of the Governor's Office of Highway Safety, said, "Many of the fatal traffic crashes on our roads are preventable, and we will continue to work with our educational and enforcement partners to develop programs and initiatives that are designed to get Georgia to our goal of zero traffic deaths."

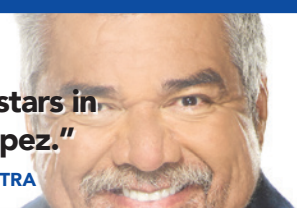

New 318-unit apartment complex opens on Fairview

COVINGTON, Ga. — Prose Fairview, a 318-unit apartment community, has opened in west Newton as developers respond to Newton County projected to see job growth and over \$5 billion in economic development in the next few years. Alliance Residential announced the opening of the complex at 3655 Fairview Road in Covington.

Alliance partnered with Atlanta architectural firm Dynamik Design to build the complex, a news release stated.

Located on more than 36 acres at 3655 Fairview Road in Covington, the community includes 318 one-bedroom and two-bedroom apartment units averaging 996 square feet.

“With Covington rapidly gaining a reputation as the next ‘boomtown’ in the Atlanta metropolitan area, we are thrilled to open the doors to the much-anticipated Prose Fairview, our newest apartment community designed

specifically to serve residents seeking well-appointed apartment living near one of the fastest growing employment corridors,” said Alliance Residential Company Managing Director Noah Randall.

“As more individuals with modern taste relocate to the area, this community pairs thoughtfully curated design and lifestyle amenities with the ease of access to work and play for a high quality of living.”

The units feature custom white shaker cabinets, granite countertops, a dining-sized entertainment kitchen island, kitchen and linen pantries, stainless steel appliances, chrome plumbing fixtures, wood plank-style flooring throughout, walk-in closets in all bedrooms, and side-by-side Samsung washers and dryers.

Rents range from \$1,375 for a one-bedroom unit to \$1,610 for a two-bedroom unit.

Newton jobless rate drops

COVINGTON, Ga. — Newton County’s unemployment rate

dropped in September as more residents joined the labor force and found employment.

Newton’s jobless rate

was 2.9%, which was down 0.6% from 3.5% in August. The rate was 3.9% in September 2021.

A total of 54,592 Newton County resident were in the labor force, up from 54,383 in August. A total of 52,995 county residents were employed up from 52,498 in August, according to statistics from the Georgia Department of Labor.

The county’s rate was above the statewide rate of 2.6% and the Metro Atlanta rate of 2.5%.

Georgia Labor Commissioner Mark Butler said that all regions of the state recorded a drop in unemployment rates in September.

“We continue to see a steady rise in job creation and demand by employers to fill open positions,” said Commissioner Mark Butler.

ed "hundreds" of teens — was held inside of an event venue in the Dollar General-anchored shopping center at 3269 Salem Road near the Rockdale County line.

A video posted on social media that went viral showed a violent confrontation between two girls amid a large group of teens outside the venue started the melee, which prompted other fights. As attendees rushed to videotape the fights on their phones, others hurried to leave the premises on foot or by vehicle. Gunshots soon could be heard ringing out on the video.

Deputies reported responding to a gun discharging in the area of the shopping center.

"Dispatch advised that they were receiving multiple calls in reference to gunfire coming from the area of an event venue in the parking lot of Salem Square shopping center," the report stated.

One deputy on the scene wrote, "Upon my arrival, there were hundreds of kids running around, along with cars leaving the area."

"I was walking through the parking lot with other law enforcement officers to make sure no one was hurt or shot."

Area residents using the Neighbors Ring

app wrote they saw teens running from the scene as they drove nearby.

"I just picked up a group of kids and was scared for them and me," one app user wrote.

"Do not open your doors. There are people banging on doors for help," another user wrote.

Deputies brought teens from the party to the NCSO's West-side precinct on Salem Road for parents to pick them up, according to comments by area residents on the app.

not expanding Georgia's Medicaid program under the Affordable Care Act Congress passed in 2010, a step she said would provide health-care access to 500,000 currently uninsured Georgians.

Kemp is scheduled to be in the Newton County area Friday at 3:30 p.m. at the Walton County Historic Courthouse in Monroe with former New Jersey governor Chris Christie as part of Kemp's statewide bus tour.

If the economy is Kemp's top issue this year, crime is a close second, Capitol Beat News reported.

Kemp created a Crime Suppression Unit last year to use law enforcement personnel from several state agencies to help local police departments fight a pandemic-driven crime wave.

The unit has served warrants on more than 600 criminal suspects, including 29 murder warrants.

Kemp has accused Abrams of being soft on crime by supporting an end to cash bail and has charged Democrats in general with wanting to "defund" the police, a talking point Republicans across the country have used to attack their opponents.

Abrams has countered that Kemp's backing of legislation the Republican-controlled General Assembly enacted this year to let gun owners carry concealed firearms without a permit is making Georgians less safe.

"Street gangs are not the reason people are getting shot in grocery stores, parking lots, and schools. ... We have a gov-

ernor who has weakened gun laws across our state."

Kemp, who opposes Medicaid expansion as too expensive, called it a "broken government program." His administration's proposals for a more limited version of Medicaid expansion have been rejected by the federal Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services.

Kemp said during a debate earlier this month that he would not push for abortion restrictions beyond the heartbeat law, which includes exceptions for rape and incest, if a police report is filed, when the mother's life is at risk, or if a serious medical condition renders a fetus unviable.

Abrams pointed to polls that show most Georgia voters oppose the heartbeat law.

Rituals may bring healing to our pain, loss

This week, people around the world mark celebrations of saints as well as a time to honor, pay respects and pray for the dead. The holidays of All Hallows' Eve (Halloween), All Saints' Day, and All Souls' Day take place on Oct. 31, Nov. 1, and Nov. 2, respectively. All three can trace some or all their roots within the Christian tradition and invite us to spend some time thinking about death. Not often a topic any of us want to think about until we are forced to.

In my own Protestant world, the one we will focus on the most is Nov. 1, All Saints' Day. Though the night before will certainly get some attention in our house too as we trick-or-treat with our son and his friends. The next day, though, or for some of us on the following Sunday, we will honor and remember those who have died, especially in the last year.

Pastor and writer, Nadia Bolz Weber says that All Saints' is a day when the church recognizes how thin the veil is between life and death. In a text we often read on this day, the writer in Revelation, the last and perhaps least understood book of the Bible, says, "I then saw a new heaven and a new earth... I saw the holy city, I heard a

loud voice... God's dwelling is here with humankind" (selected verses from Revelation 21:1-6).

In response to the ever-present reality of death, the writer in Revelation reminds those listening that every tear will be wiped away and death and mourning will be no more. My favorite part, though, is when we are reminded that God's dwelling is here, with us. The power in those words is not power that rules the world but power that reminds us of who does. That God has chosen to be among us through the life, ministry, death, and resurrection of Jesus as well as the all-pervasive movement of the Holy Spirit. This is a key tenet of the Christian faith.

We also recall that in this faith we live in a rare kind of hope where a new city breaks through and comes down to us, creates something new, calls us together regardless of who we are or the things that tend to divide us. Especially in an election season. It reminds us that our work is about creating the beloved community and living together in it. This is a new heaven and new earth where we are seen not simply as we are but as we should be. We are also called to see each other this way.

A signature moment for me in our All-Saints' worship is when we read and call out the names of those who

have died in the last year. In some churches, candles will be lit for each person, representing the light they shared during their life. Sometimes banners with bells on them that represent each person who has died are carried in a procession as we listen to our loved one's lives ring in our ears one more time. Prayers will be rendered for them. They will be remembered in a sacred moment as we recall the life they lived on this earth.

Though these are the traditions of the church, I invite any of you reading these words to mark the lives you may have lost in the last year or anytime. These rituals may bring healing to our pain and loss. They may open us up to the possibility of hope even in the midst of grief. Ultimately, rituals like this breathe life into our very being as they remind us of the life and legacies of those who have gone before us. May light perpetual shine on them, and may we be harbingers of hope in the various communities in which we live, work, and play.

Happy about the many voices inside my head

Last week I wrote about the nonstop, eardrum-assaulting chatter during baseball games from certain TV sports announcers. Although my complaint was limited to the fact that they don't allow viewers to enjoy the game's natural, easygoing rhythm, some of you pointed out another trend. Many of today's announcers have the same bland style, unlike the voices of games past. I couldn't agree more.

In the early days of baseball broadcasts, Mississippi-born Red Barber and Alabamian Mel Allen lavished their thick Southern accents on New York Yankees fans, of all people. Tennessee's Lindsey Nelson became a top network sportscaster. More recently, Keith Jackson of Georgia was ABC's voice of college football. Howard Cosell may be the most famous sports voice ever, with his nasal Brooklyn twang. Can you imagine a national sportscaster with a regional accent today? They're hard to find.

Distinctive voices have always been special to me. As a radio fan since childhood and a broadcaster since my teen years, I appreciate the power of a memorable voice. The men and women I grew up listening to sounded like no one else, and are forever etched in my memory.

During the second half of the 20th century, as radio and television gradually overtook print as our primary sources for news and entertainment, a voice was often our first impression of a famous person.

President Franklin D. Roosevelt's body was weak, but his voice was strong. His weekly radio "fireside chats" projected the image of a dynamic leader.

Eventual TV stars like Bob Hope, Arthur Godfrey, and Jack Benny had distinguished themselves on radio with their voices long before they became familiar faces. Unlike some of their peers, they quickly learned the secrets of playing to the camera, but their vocal style remained a key part of their success.

Early radio hosts like Bob Barker, Dick Clark, and Ronald Reagan parlayed their smooth speaking style into phenomenal TV success, becoming household names and voices. As for Reagan, a case could be made that his calming voice played a major role in two White House wins. Can you think of any other president in your lifetime who had such a strong command of public speaking? It's a very short list.

So distinctive were the voices of my youth that scores of comedians got rich simply by impersonating others. Often the likes of Jimmy Cagney, Clark Gable, and Richard Nixon were remembered more for how they were impersonated than by their own voices. All I have to say is, "You dirty rat," "Frankly, Scarlett," and "I am not a crook," and you immediately think of the impressions, not the actual people. I can't leave out the ladies. Close your eyes and you can hear the voices of Lucille Ball, Carol

Exposing Joe Biden's "Jim Crow 2.0" slander

Early voting began in Georgia on Oct. 17. There is, of course, intense interest in both the state's Senate race, with University of Georgia football legend Herschel Walker challenging Democratic Sen. Raphael Warnock, and the governor's race, between Gov. Brian Kemp and Democratic challenger Stacey Abrams. Kemp is going to win, but the Senate contest is essentially tied. Its outcome might well determine which party controls the Senate. How intense is voter interest in Georgia? Just look at turnout. People are voting early in droves. Record numbers. More than ever in a midterm election. The evidence comes from the Georgia Secretary of State's office in a weekend press release headlined, "Georgia Voters Shatter Second Presidential Turnout Record on Saturday." In other words — more people are voting in the midterm election, at this stage of early voting, than voted in the 2020 presidential election. That is huge.



The numbers: Through Oct. 23, 740,615 Georgians had voted early in person. Another 76,247 have voted absentee, for a total of 816,862. "(Oct. 22's) total marks an astounding 159% increase from day six of 2018 midterm early voting and shattered the turnout record of day six of early voting in the 2020 presidential election by 20%," the office said.

"Georgia has had record early voting turnout since the first day of early voting this year," the office continued, "surging to nearly twice the number on the first day of early voting in 2018. Totals have remained within striking distance of the 2020 presidential election turnout, and have shattered previous midterm turnout records by 50% or greater during every day of early voting this week."

Many of the early voters are black. Indeed, the group Black Voters Matter issued a press release celebrating black turnout in the first days of voting. "Black Voters in Georgia have done it again!" the group said. "Voter turnout in Georgia reached historic highs on the first day of early voting in this midterm election, and Black Voters

comprised 35% of all those who turned out to vote. ... We at Black Voters Matter never doubted the commitment of Black voters to use the ballot box to bring about change." About 30% of Georgia's registered voters, and about 33% of its population as a whole, are black, meaning the black turnout in early voting is quite strong.

Of course, the numbers are remarkable in themselves. But what makes them truly extraordinary is that Georgia's enthusiastic turnout is coming after many Democrats, including the president of the United States, pronounced Georgia a hellhole of voter suppression in which racist authorities imposed Jim Crow-era rules in an effort to prevent thousands, or tens of thousands, or hundreds of thousands of Democrats, many of them minorities, from voting. The cause was a new voter reform law passed by the Republican-controlled Georgia legislature. Time after time, the president referred to the law as "Jim Crow." Did he really say that? Yes, he did. Here are eight examples:

Use excess funds instead of asking for SPLOST renewal

Dear Editor,

Newton County voters will decide many important political races on Nov. 8, 2022. And, we will even get to decide whether to continue to tax ourselves for another six years. That's because extension of the 1-cent Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax, or SPLOST, is on the ballot. This time, the vote is during a general election when a large number of voters will decide the question unlike in the March 2017 SPLOST special election when only 4.3% of Newton voters went to the polls.

The new 2023 SPLOST is projected to generate \$108 million over the next six years. County government will receive about \$84.6 million of that with the five cities receiving the remainder. The list of projects and their estimated cost has been well publicized, but do we need to extend the SPLOST tax now to get some of these projects underway? I don't think so because extra funds are

available from the 2017 SPLOST and other sources.

The list of projects for the 2017 SPLOST includes the usual mix of obviously needed things like debt retirement, road improvements, and government building renovations. But, there are also nice-to-have projects like parks and "improvements" in specific county commissioner's districts. Look closely at the 2023 SPLOST and you will see similar questionable projects like another \$1 million for Commissioner Henderson's Nelson Heights Center, and a \$5 million park for a different commissioner.

The 2017 SPLOST was projected to bring in \$64.8 million through June 2023. So, how much is the current SPLOST generating? According to county financial data, the current SPLOST is expected to bring in \$98 million when it ends in June 2023, meaning an extra \$33 million

On March 25, 2021, Biden said, "This makes Jim Crow look like Jim Eagle. I mean, this is gigantic what they're trying to do, and it cannot be sustained."

On March 26, 2021, Biden said, "This is Jim Crow in the 21st century. It must end."

On June 22, 2021, Biden praised Democrats in Congress for standing together "against the ongoing assault of voter suppression that represents a Jim Crow era in the 21st century."

On July 13, 2021, Biden said, "The 21st-century Jim Crow assault is real. It's unrelenting."

On July 21, 2021, Biden said, "This is Jim Crow on steroids."

On July 26, 2021, Biden decried "attacks on the right to vote unseen since the days of the Jim Crow system."

On Oct. 21, 2021, speaking at the Martin Luther King Jr. Memorial in Washington, Biden said, "Jim Crow in the 21st century is now a sinister combination of voter suppression and election subversion."

On Jan. 11, 2022, speaking in Atlanta, Biden said, "Jim Crow 2.0 is about two insidious things: voter suppression and election subversion. ... It's not hyperbole; this is a fact."

Biden's words, which were echoed by the vice president, Democrats in the House and Senate, Democrats in state legislatures and their many allies in the media, were the inspiration for literally thousands of references to Jim Crow in public discussion of the Georgia law. The point was clear: This was a racist voter-suppression law.

Biden's Justice Department filed suit against Georgia, alleging that "several provisions [of the law] were adopted with the purpose of denying or abridging the right to vote on account of race." Big corporations and institutions got involved, too. The 2021 Major League Baseball All-Star Game was scheduled to be held in Atlanta, but MLB officials were scared by all the

controversy. Biden said publicly that he would "strongly support" moving the game out of Georgia. The league went along, ordering that the game be played in Denver instead. The move cost the state of Georgia and its citizens millions of dollars.

Delta Airlines is Georgia's biggest employer. On March 31, 2021, CEO Ed Bastian wrote, "I need to make it crystal clear that the final bill is unacceptable and does not match Delta's values." Another big Georgia-based business, Coca-Cola, said something quite similar. "I want to be crystal clear," said Coke CEO James Quincey, "The Coca-Cola Company does not support this legislation, as it makes it harder for people to vote, not easier."

So now, huge numbers of Georgia voters, including huge numbers of black voters, are taking part in the 2022 midterm elections. There is no Jim Crow 2.0. There is no Jim Crow on steroids. There is no 21st-century Jim Crow. It should be said that this is not a surprise. Many observers noted at the time that the Georgia bill would make incremental improvements in the state's voting procedures and would not in any way hinder the ability of Georgians to vote. They noted at the time that Biden's Jim Crow talk was ugly demagoguery. They tried, unsuccessfully, to cool down all the media talk that amplified Biden's ugly demagoguery.

In the end, the Georgia legislature and other state officials did not back down. The law is now in effect. And voters are voting in droves. Voting is so suppressed that turnout records are being broken on a daily basis. Do not look for President Biden or those who echoed his words to apologize. That's not going to happen. But events have proven them wrong, wrong, wrong.

will be available. That sounds like a windfall of money to me! How can it be best spent? Well, no worries there. The county commissioners already have plans for the excess money.

Here are some examples. The West Side Youth Facility budgeted in the 2017 SPLOST for \$495,427 now has an increased budget of \$4.25 million — eight times the cost originally shown to voters. District 2 improvements also budgeted at \$495,427 now has a new cost of \$1.25 million. Senior Services expansion and the Washington Street Center each got another \$1 million added to the cost stated on the 2017 ballot. Also, the Springhill Park's budget was increased by \$3 million! The picture is clear. The extra funds being brought in are being quickly snapped up by our county commission.

It seems that the cost of projects the voters were shown for the 2017 SPLOST were just "guessimates," and I think misleading ones. While only 2,004 citizens voted in 2017 to approve the SPLOST project list at

costs specified on the ballot, would even that few number have approved those projects at a cost two to eight times those amounts? That is a good question.

What about the new 2023 SPLOST proposal? Do voters understand that the costs shown on this Nov. 8 ballot are only rough estimates? Do they know that the county and cities could spend the extra \$33 million from the 2017 SPLOST for many like projects on the 2023 list? It is doubtful that most know that the county still has over \$1 million in excess revenue from the 2011 SPLOST and over \$4 million in the impact fee fund also available.

These excess funds should be spent in ways that would postpone the need for the SPLOST tax to continue in 2023. If you agree, vote NO when you cast your Nov. 8 ballot.

Obama urges turnout for Georgia Democrats

ATLANTA— With just 10 days to go before the election, former President Barack Obama urged Georgia Democrats Friday to turn out for gubernatorial challenger Stacey Abrams, U.S. Sen. Raphael Warnock and other Democrats down the ballot.

Obama drew a stark contrast between Georgia's Democratic and Republican candidates, arguing that Warnock and Abrams would best represent the interests of working Georgians.

"The basic, one fundamental question you should be asking yourself is who cares about you, who believes in you?" Obama told the cheering crowd. "That's the choice in this election."

Obama lauded both Warnock, who is seeking a full term in the Senate, and Abrams, who is trying for a second time to beat Republican Gov. Brian Kemp.

"You have Democrats like Rev. Warnock who have shown they will take on the drug companies to lower prices and get the oil industry to clean up its act and pass laws to make housing more affordable and make sure that corporations bring jobs here into Georgia instead of overseas," Obama said.

"[Abrams is] focused on making sure every Georgian has an opportunity to get ahead. That's why she wants to invest Georgia's surplus in good schools, a higher standard of living and more affordable health care and housing."

Obama pointed to the two parties' differences on abortion as another reason why Georgians should vote blue.

"Who will fight for your freedoms?" he asked. "Is it gonna be GOP politicians, judges who think they get to decide when you start a family, how many children you have, who you marry? Or is it Democratic leaders who believe the freedom to make these personal intimate decisions belong to every American, not to politicians in Washington?"

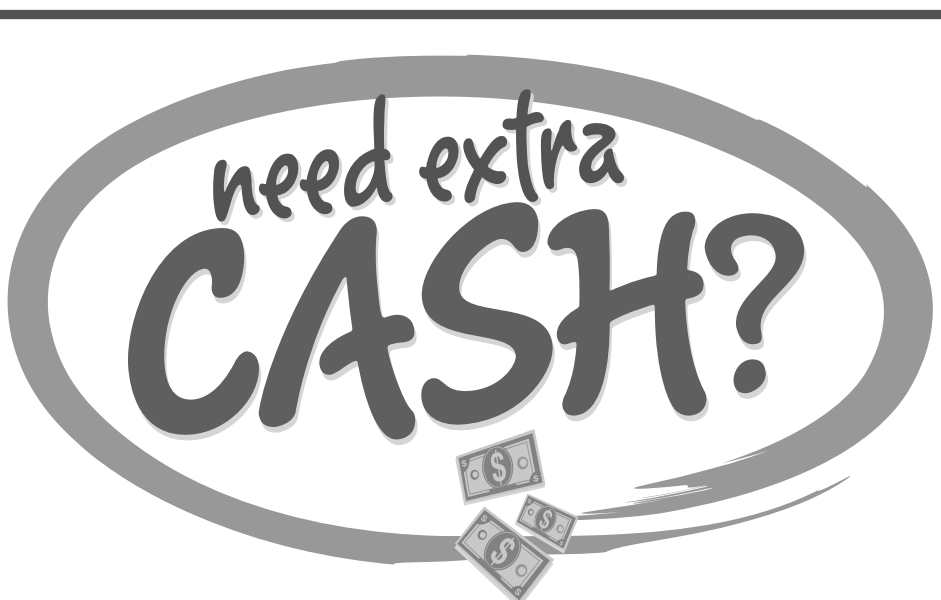
Obama warned that Republicans capturing control of both the U.S. House and Senate could put America just a presidential election away from a nationwide ban on abortion.

"Most of the GOP ... are not even pretending that the rules apply to them anymore," he said. "Last year, Stacey's opponent [Kemp] signed one of the most aggressive voter suppression laws."

"Democracy is at stake in this election. That's why it's not enough to elect Democrats at the top of the ticket. That's why we need to work just as hard to elect secretaries of state like [Georgia Democratic candidate] Bee Nguyen."

Obama also zeroed in on recent serious allegations about Republican Senate candidate Herschel Walker's character and preparation for office.

"Herschel Walker was a heck of a football player," Obama said, referring to Walker's star turn as a University of Georgia running back. "But Walker is not prepared to hold a Senate seat. Remember, these are issues of character. You deserve better."

nate with the players come playoff time.

"I told them half-way through the year, 'We have to finish games,'" Davis said. "It wasn't when we had leads that we needed to finish, it was when we got to this moment the past couple of days. Friday afternoon featured a Region 5A-Division I rematch with region champion Prince Avenue. Social Circle, who finished region runners up to the Lady Wolverines, eliminated Prince Avenue from the playoffs with a 3-2 victory.

To advance to the state title, the Lady Redskins downed Pepperell 3-2 Saturday morning.

Davis mentioned how he felt like his message for the second half of the season seemed to reso-

Delicious soup is perfect for the cooler weather of fall

Cooler weather arrives just as prime entertaining season heats up. Those who will be hosting gatherings soon can expand their recipe repertoire to feed guests and keep them satisfied. Borrowing some flavors from the season can make entertaining festive and even more flavorful. Pumpkins and winter squashes are popular in fall, and their versatility undoubtedly contributes to that popularity. However, when chilly days require something to warm you up from the inside out, nothing can beat a soothing soup. And soup recipes can be altered to easily



feed a crowd. Cooks can step out of their chicken soup comfort zones and try this recipe for "Roasted Pumpkin Soup With Pumpkin Crisps" from "The Complete Mexican, South American & Caribbean Cookbook" (Metro Books) by Jane Milton, Jenni Fleetwood and Marina Filippeli.

Roasted Pumpkin Soup With Pumpkin Crisps

Serves 6 to 8
3 to 3-1/2 pounds pumpkin

6 tablespoons olive oil
2 onions, chopped
3 garlic cloves, chopped
1 3-inch piece of fresh ginger root, grated
1 teaspoon ground coriander
1/2 teaspoon ground turmeric
Pinch of cayenne pepper
4 cups vegetable stock
Salt and ground black pepper
1 tablespoon sesame seeds
Fresh cilantro leaves, to garnish

For the pumpkin crisps

Wedge of fresh pumpkin, seeded
1/2 cup olive oil
1. Preheat the oven to 400 F. Prick the pumpkin around the top several times with a fork.

Brush the pumpkin with plenty of the oil and bake for 45 minutes or until tender. Leave until cool enough to handle.

2. Take care when cutting the pumpkin, as there may still be a lot of hot steam inside. When cool enough to handle, scoop out and discard the seeds. Scoop out and chop the flesh.

3. Heat about 4 tablespoons of the remaining oil (you may not have to use all of it) in a large pan and add the onions, garlic and ginger, then cook gently for 4 to 5 minutes. Add the coriander, turmeric, and cayenne, and cook for 2 minutes. Stir in the pumpkin flesh and stock. Bring to a boil, re-

duce the heat, and simmer for about 20 minutes until tender.

4. Cool the soup slightly, then puree it in a food processor or blender until smooth. Return the soup to the rinsed out pan and season well.

5. Meanwhile, prepare the pumpkin crisps. Using a swivel-blade potato peeler, pare long thin strips off the wedge of pumpkin. Heat the oil in a small pan and fry the strips in batches for 2 to 3 minutes, until crisp. Drain on paper towels.

6. Reheat the soup and ladle it into bowls. Top with the pumpkin crisps and garnish each portion with sesame seeds and cilantro leaves.

Serves 12

1 bone-in fully cooked ham (about 5-1/2 pounds)
1 cup apple cider
1/2 cup dark brown sugar
1/3 cup bourbon (preferably Kentucky)
1/4 cup honey
1/4 cup Dijon style mustard
4 sprigs fresh thyme

Place the ham in a large slow cooker. Whisk the cider with the brown sugar, bourbon, honey, and mustard. Slowly pour over the ham. Scatter the thyme sprigs into the slow cooker.

Cook on high for four hours or on low for eight hours, or until very tender. Remove ham to rest on a cutting board. Pass the remaining cooking liquid through a fine mesh sieve into a saucepan. Simmer for 10 minutes or until slightly reduced.

Cut the ham into chunks or slices. Brush the cut pieces with the cooking liquid before arranging on a platter. Serve warm or at room temperature.

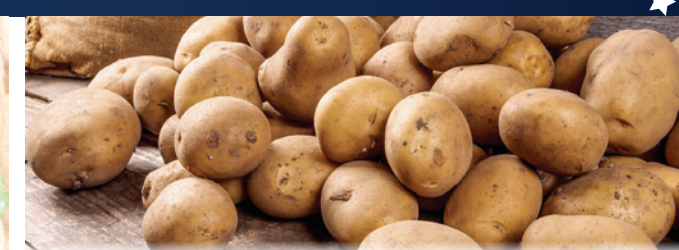

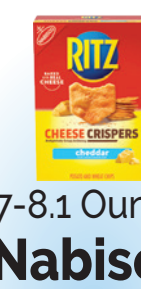

It's 'Lopez vs. Lopez' in NBC's new parent-and-child sitcom

Relations haven't always been rosy between George Lopez and his daughter, and they don't mind the world knowing it.

The comedian and his offspring Mayan play versions of themselves as they revisit their relationship – which was very fractured for some time – in "Lopez vs. Lopez," an NBC comedy premiering next Friday, Nov. 4. Co-stars include Matt Shively and Selenis Leyva, and while humor largely is used to show the on-screen family's dysfunction, the real-life George and Mayan admit their estrangement and reconciliation hasn't been a laughing matter in many moments.

"My parents got divorced about 10 years ago," Mayan Lopez says, "and within the last two years, my dad and I really solidified our relationship. There was a time where we didn't speak and were estranged for about three years, but the pandemic brought us back together, and I started making TikToks with my family to reconnect. And ('Lopez vs. Lopez' executive producer) Debby Wolfe was scrolling one day and she saw one of our TikToks, and this was kind of born from that idea."

George Lopez notes differences between doing the new show and having made the earlier sitcoms "George Lopez," "Saint George" and "Lopez." He reflects that after the NBC premiere of an episode, "The next day, you're on (the

streaming service) Peacock, and then on you're on NBC again. I think as times have changed, social media has changed and the comedy has changed, yet the (approach) of multicamera (production) doesn't change. To have done it 20 years ago is great, but (so is) to do it now, with people that are incredibly talented and much easier to find than it was 20 years ago."

Wolfe opines, "That's because George Lopez and the show 'George Lopez' really did pave the way and opened up a lot of doors and inspired a lot of Latinx talent to pursue their dreams. And now, here we are. We do have so much great talent (of that ethnicity) coming in, and it is different than it was in the past."

Executive producer Bruce Helford ("The Drew Carey Show," "Roseanne") believes "Lopez vs. Lopez" will be "a fun game for viewers to watch and go, 'Ooh, all of a sudden, there is something there that's very real.' It's an amazing thing to watch, that both George and Mayan are so open to exploring all the things ... not just with the writers, but also what they have to bring from their own experiences together."

Adds Mayan, "This is an experience of a lifetime, to be able to do this with my father. I have studied to be a comedian, but really, the inception of my love of comedy started at a young age."

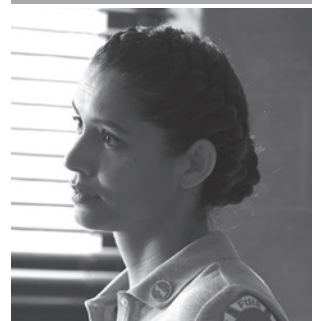

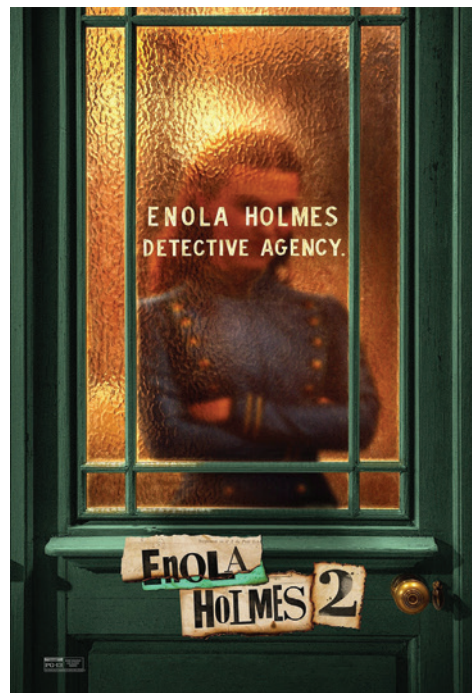

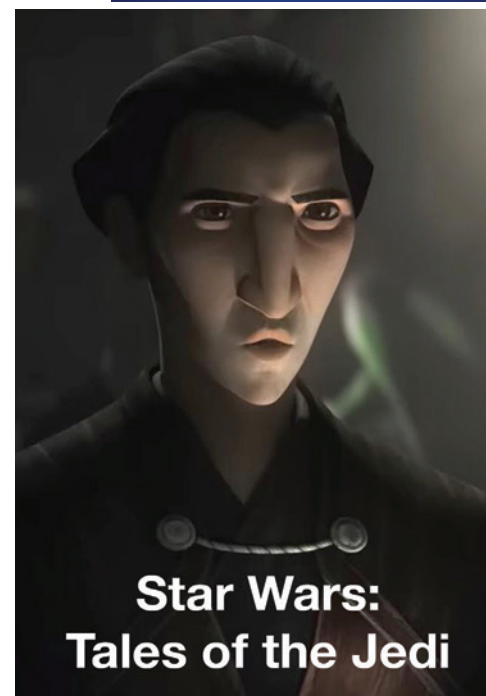

What attracted you to the role of a young John Winchester in the “Supernatural” prequel “The Winchesters”?

Well, I was a huge “Supernatural” fan in and of itself as the canon series. ... So when I saw the pilot come across back in March, I was definitely intrigued, super-skeptical when I first picked it up because I was like, “I don’t know.”

You know, when there’s such a successful series as “Supernatural” was, I think your initial instinct is if you’re going to do a prequel or you do any type of sequel, it’s got to have its own angle, it’s got to have some originality to it. Because I think the mistake a lot of series make when they do those is they’re just trying to recreate what they had, which can sometimes come off as a little bit more of a cash grab situation. And so that was where my skepticism lied, is like I don’t want it to be that. And then after reading the script and getting to talk to (executive producers) Robbie (Thompson), Jensen (Ackles) and all them, it was super, super clear that it

wasn’t that. It was super clear that they have an artistic vision and have a very specific angle in which they want to play with this. And so yeah, I was immediately drawn to (it).

So in your approach to the character, Jensen must have been a fantastic resource, correct?

Oh yeah, Jensen’s incredible. Jensen has been instrumental in every part of this character and this creation because ... he knows the character. He knows the character probably better than anyone because of how he modeled Dean Winchester, was after his father. So he created a lot because Jeffrey (Dean Morgan, who played an older John in “Supernatural”) was only really heavily in that first and second season and then he became more scattered throughout. And so a lot of who John Winchester is is created at how Dean perceived him. And so Jensen’s been an incredible resource to that and he’s always a phone call away or when he comes to visit set it’s just fantastic and much, much appreciated.

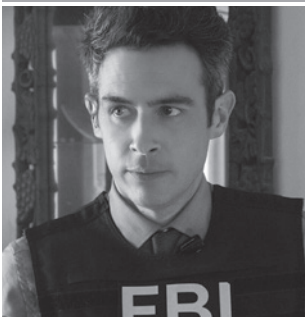
